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Information Collection

Cookies

The term “cookies” refers to a common method of storing information about your activity on a given website. Scope

We may also collect other categories of personal information that you choose to share with us.

Sources of personal information

We may collect personal information from your interaction with marketing communications, and your participation in events from joint marketing partners and event sponsors when they share this information with us.

How we share personal information

We may disclose for business purposes all of the categories of personal information described above with the following categories of third parties:

- *Online services.* If you use our website, or any social media that we operate and/or any services provided through them (collectively, "online services"), we use your general identifiers, online identifiers, internet activity information (as described above) and other information that you submit through the online services for:
 - Hosting and events.  - Research and development. As part of these activities, we may create aggregated, de-identified or other anonymous data from personal information we collect. We render personal information into anonymous data by removing information that makes the data personally identifiable.
